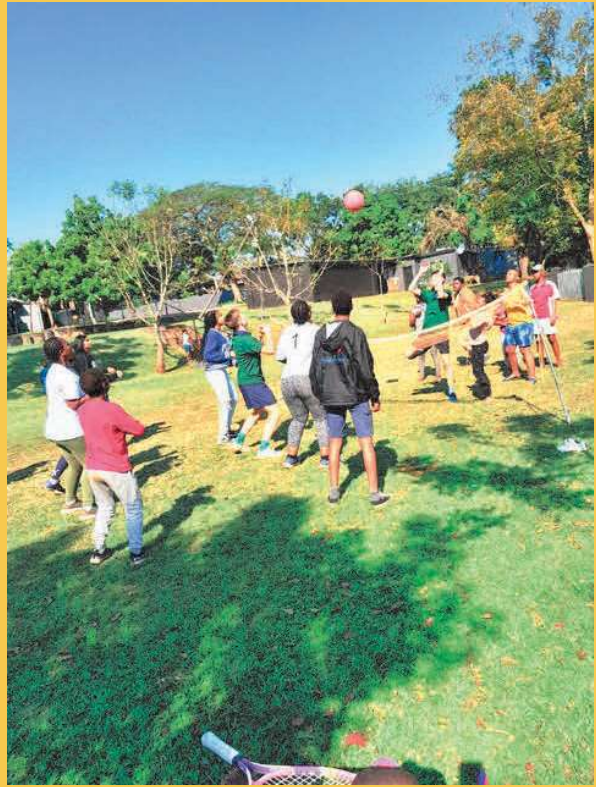
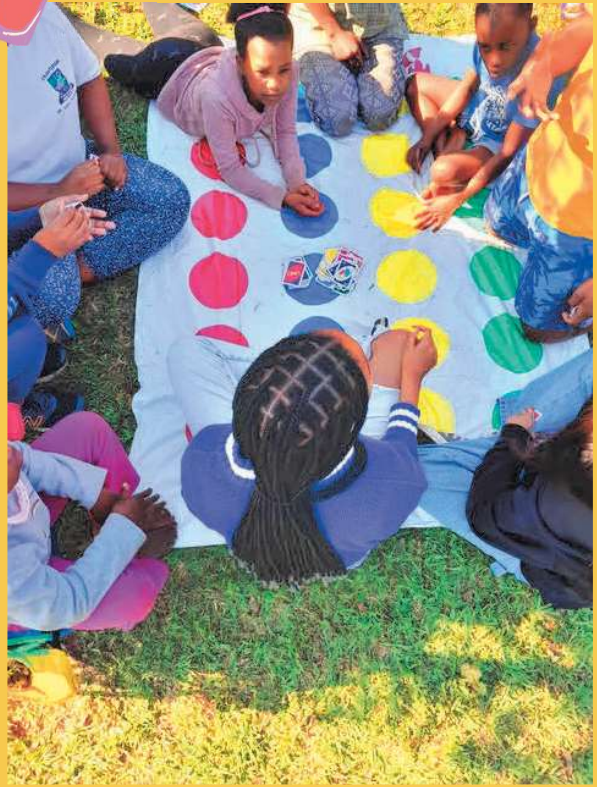
On the first day, the kids painted with forks and fingers/ hands making bright and colourful art.
