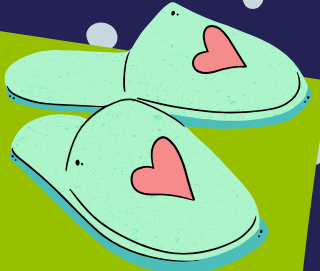
# Fire Safety
