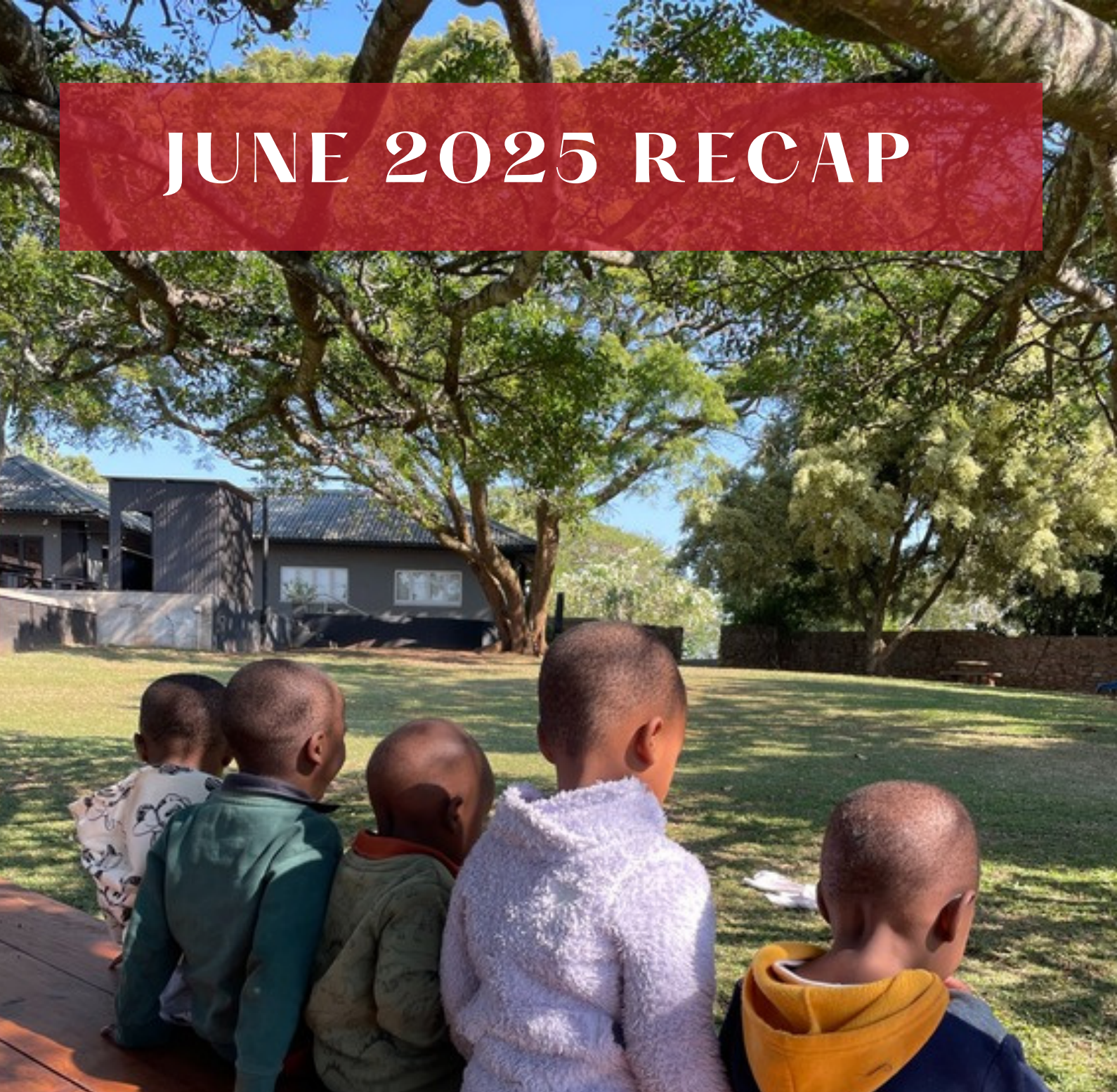

HAPPY BIRTHDAY !

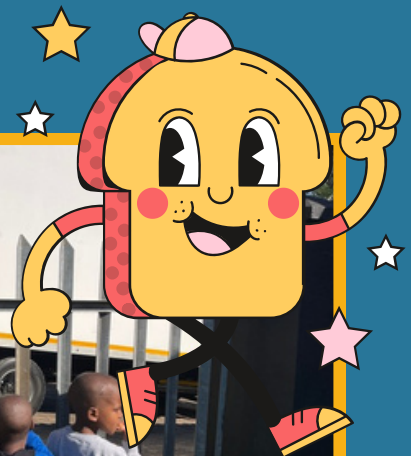
