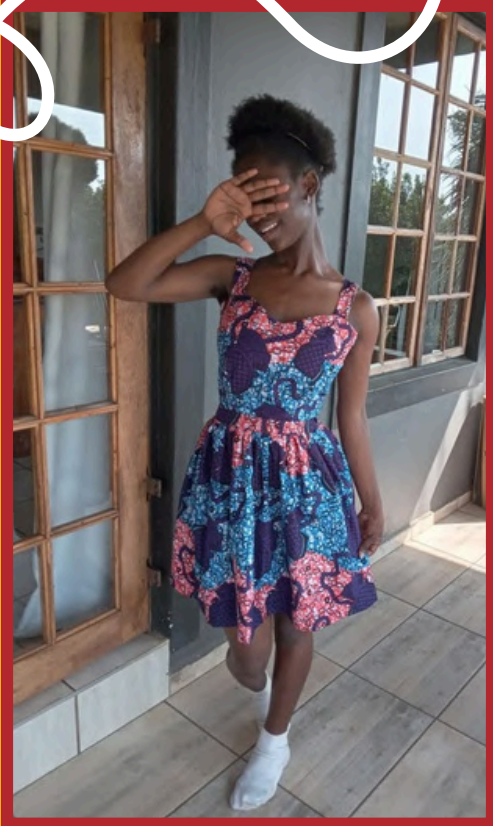


HERITAGE DAY
